Dear Mr. McWhinney:

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has reviewed the King Schools, Inc. *Private Pilot Syllabus* Ver 1.0 for initial private pilot certification for airplane single-engine land. The FAA finds that the content of this syllabus appears to meet acceptable training standards for use under Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) part 141. The syllabus contains sufficient ground and flight training hours needed to be eligible for the private pilot certificate with an airplane single-engine land rating. The syllabus is adequate in scope and content for use under part 141 provided all relevant part 141 requirements are adhered to.

It is not a function of this office to certificate 14 CFR part 141 schools, and this letter is not to be construed as an authorization to conduct part 141 operations. We are only acknowledging that the material presented to the FAA's General Aviation and Commercial Division, AFS-800, would be appropriate for use in a certificated part 141 training environment. The authorization to operate a part 141 school using this syllabus or any other training material is and remains a function of the jurisdictional Flight Standards District Office (FSDO).
